Getting to know our members and their Thunderbirds

Don Morton & His Custom '55 Thunderbird

In 1958 Don became the third owner of this '55 Thunderbird. However, his story with the car began in 1955 when the second owner contracted him to sketch a rather radical custom design for the Bird.

Don's creation began to take shape using a very early Ford dealer poster for the art work. It was designed to be shown, but also to be driven and enjoyed. With the concept complete, the construction and restoration were contracted to Clarkaiser, a well-known custom shop on Warren Avenue in Detroit. All body work was accomplished with metal and lead, using no plastic filler. Custom parts were fabricated using pieces from other cars to create the bumpers, fender skirts and more.

Soon after completion, Don became the third owner and began showing the Bird, immediately winning many awards at events including the Ford Rotunda, Detroit Autorama, Boca Raton Fl., the Gilmore and many others.

During the early years he did some engine modifications and raced the Bird at the Detroit Drag Way. Due to the many pounds of lead in the construction, he did not set any records, but thoroughly enjoyed the experience.

Don was no stranger to speed, having set a wheeled vehicle speed record of 202 MPH on the Bonneville Salt Flats with his modified 1930 Ford Model A.

Don's pride and enjoyment of his creation continues to this day.
